- 1. The study must emphasize the significance of multimedia technologies in spreading knowledge about multimedia tools, simulations, virtual reality, and laboratory learning. The section on student learning should highlight the positive impact of multimedia resources on motivation, independent working, and achieving success.
- 2. The sections on access to training must show that teachers' access to training is critical in promoting teaching and the learning process of teachers.
- 3. The methodology section needs to be well-structured and provides a clear description of the research design, data collection, and analysis.
- 4. The use of descriptive and inferential statistics must be more appropriate; more detail could be provided about the specific statistical tests used and how they were chosen.
- 5. Regarding the Results section, the demographic data needs to be presented clearly in the Table, and the descriptive summary and factor loadings must also be presented in the Table.
