Abstract: *Aspergillus tubingensis* spondylitis (AS) is a rare clinical spinal infectious diseases with severe clinical symptoms and and challenging diagnosis. Treatment of AS is difficult due to its long duration, obvious side effects, and complex drug-drug interactions. However, there is none study of clinical pharmacists performing individualized treatment of AS, especially in the presence of rifampicin (which produces sustained liver enzyme induction) during the treatment process. We report a case that clinical pharmacists developed an individualized treatment plan for AS after considering the post-induction effect of rifampicin on drug-metabolizing enzymes after discontinuation and drug interactions with voriconazole (VRZ). We also paid attention to changes in indicators during treatment, managed adverse reactions, and optimized the treatment plan by monitoring voriconazole levels. After 33 days treatment in the hospital, the patient's incision healed well, and she was discharged with significant improvement. Individualized pharmaceutical care by a clinical pharmacist can help manage the treatment of *Aspergillus tubingensis* spondylitis. Drug-drug and drug-diet interactions may affect VRZ efficacy. Individualized dose adjustment using therapeutic drug monitoring (TDM) is critical to improve efficacy and reduce adverse reactions.
